

## Chicago Botanic Garden

The Chicago Botanic Garden is a wonderful, peaceful place to visit, and it is very accessible by bicycle. From Wilmette's Village Hall, the round-trip distance to the south gate of the Botanic Garden (on Dundee Road) is about 20 miles.

Note – this ride starts from the Wilmette Village Hall, 1200 Wilmette Avenue, Wilmette, Illinois. While there are many ways to get from Wilmette to the Botanic Garden, perhaps the most enjoyable is the route through the Forest Preserves.

Turn	Direction	Distance (Miles)	Street/Location
	West	0.0	From Wilmette Village Hall onto Wilmette Avenue
Left	South	2.4	Hibbard Road
Right	West	2.7	Glenview Road
Right	North	3.3	East Glenwood Road (the first possible right turn after what USED to be the railroad tracks)
Left	West	3.5	Wilmette Avenue
Right	North	4.0	Turn north on the trail in Harms Woods (on the west side of Harms Road, opposite Wilmette Avenue).
Straight	Northerly	10.0	Follow the trail to the south entrance to the Botanic Garden. See the map at: <a href="http://www.chicagobotanic.org/visit/biking">http://www.chicagobotanic.org/visit/biking</a>

Follow the directions in reverse to return home.
