

Skokie Northshore Sculpture Park

The Skokie Northshore Sculpture Park is located on the east side of McCormick Boulevard, between Dempster Street and Touhy Avenue in the Village of Skokie, Illinois, adjacent to the north channel of the Chicago River.

- The Sculpture Park is fully accessible to persons with disabilities.
- It is open all year.
- Admission is free.

Note – this ride starts from the Wilmette Village Hall, 1200 Wilmette Avenue, Wilmette, Illinois

Turn	Direction	Distance (Miles)	Street/Location
	West	0.0	From Wilmette Village Hall onto Wilmette Avenue
Left	South	0.2	Park Avenue
Dogleg Left	South	0.5	At Isabella Street, take a slight dog-leg to your left to continue south on McDaniel Avenue in Evanston
Left	East	1.4	Payne Street
Bear Right	Southeast	1.8	Bridge Street (Cross McCormick Boulevard at the light at Bridge Street)
Right	South	1.8	Multiuse Trail, on your right through the parking lot between McCormick Boulevard and the north channel of the Chicago River. (Caution – ALL street crossings are major streets; all are controlled by traffic lights. Be VERY careful at street crossings.)
Straight	South	3.1	At Dempster Street. The actual Sculpture Park runs from Dempster Street to Touhy Avenue
Straight	South	5.1	Touhy Avenue – the southern end of the Sculpture Park

Turn around at Touhy Avenue, and follow the directions in reverse to return home.
